Global Environment Centre is a non-profit organisation established in 1998 to address key environmental issues. GEC is based in Malaysia and supports activities worldwide.

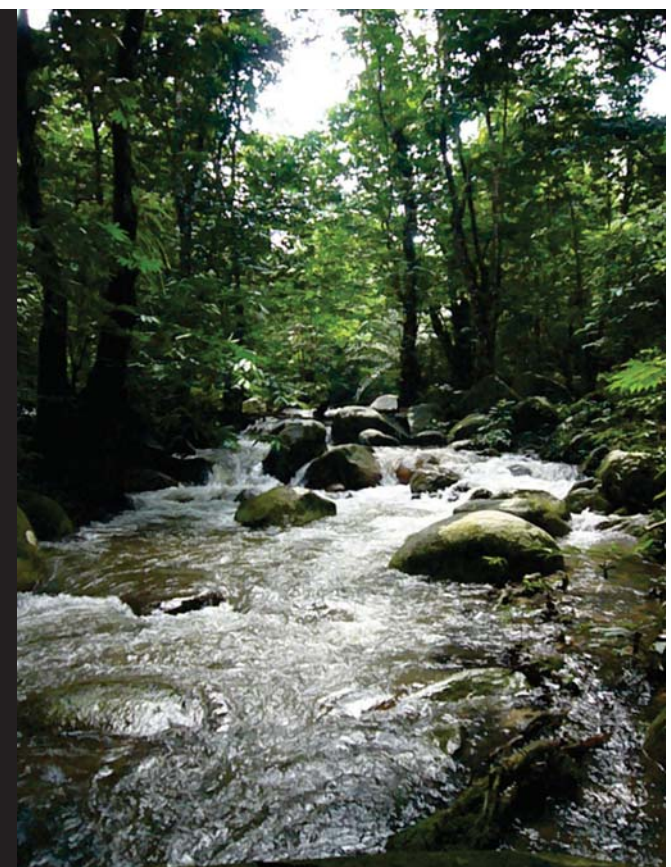
## OUR MISSION
